A check or money order for the full amount must accompany the entry form. Absolutely no entries taken after April 19th---all entries must be notarized---no exceptions. There will not be a notary on site. A \$15 late entry fee will be assessed and collected before the performance. A \$20 returned check fee will be charged. Only cash will be accepted on site. The girl and boy with the most points (pee-wee/junior AND inter./senior) will be awarded the all-around saddles. In the pee-wee/junior girl saddle, only the top 5 events for pee-wee girls will be considered since there are 5 junior girl events. Team roping points do not count towards all-around saddles. In the event of a tie for the all-around saddles, the tie will be broken with "most events" and/or "head to head" contestant analysis. All CTJRA Rules will apply unless otherwise noted in the rodeo office. A barrier will not be used. **Helmets required** in roughstock events including Mutton Busting. All participants must furnish their own equipment. No horses on the grass except in specified areas. Horses may not be tied to the fences or trees.
